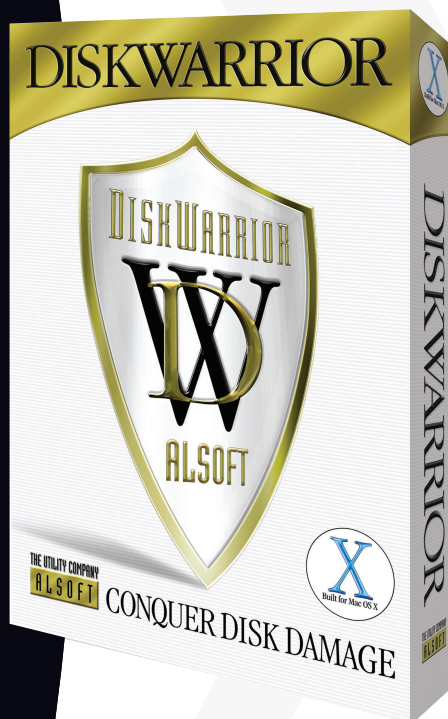

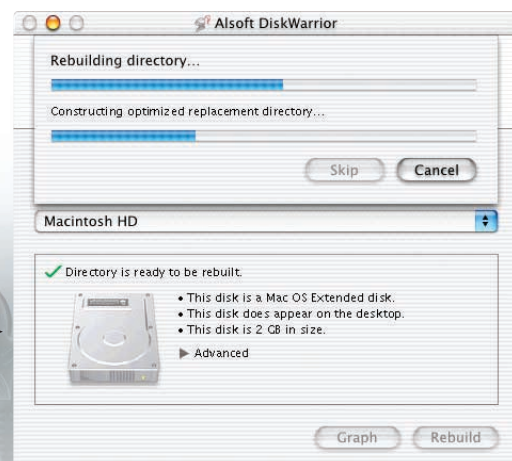

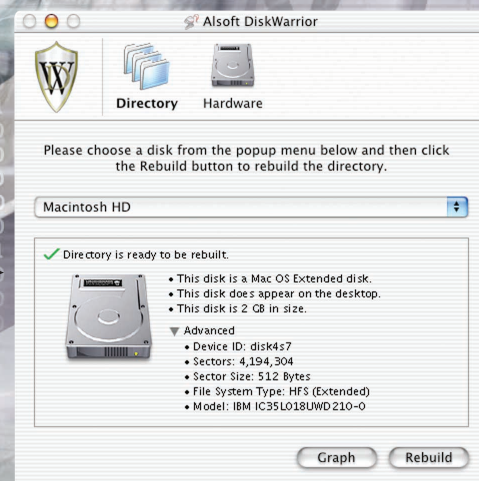

REQUIREMENTS

DiskWarrior supports any Mac OS Standard (HFS) or Mac OS Extended (HFS Plus) disk, including journaled disks. The Mac OS X version (shown) requires a Mac based on a G3 or better processor (such as a G4 or G5) with built-in USB and a minimum of 128 MB (256 MB recommended) of RAM to start up and run from the DiskWarrior CD. To install, you must be started from Mac OS 10.2.1 or later. Version 2.1 of DiskWarrior, also included, runs and installs on a 68020 Mac or better when started from Mac OS 7.1 to 9.x. Either version of DiskWarrior repairs any supported disk, no matter which version of the Mac OS is installed on the disk being repaired.
